This year marks 24 years of teaching experience for Ceil Humphreys. For six years she taught at The First Academy, where she was the sixth grade team leader and high school newspaper adviser. She began tutoring homeschool students in 1997. In 2000, 100% of her sixth grade students qualified for the Duke Talent Identification Program (top 5% in the nation in standardized test scores), and a high percentage of her students qualify each year. Rapolas Binkys, the “bad grammar bandit” at the bottom right, qualified for state recognition from Duke TIP in all three areas of the College Board SAT (critical reading, math, writing) as seventh grader. This is a first for HJH.

Mrs. Humphreys received her Bachelor of Science degree in education from the University of Georgia and worked toward a masters degree in educational computing at the University of South Florida. She holds a Florida certification in elementary education and middle school math.

An avid volunteer, Mrs. Humphreys has taught computer classes to everyone from children to adults, served as PTA president and helped create a school publishing center for her sons’ school.
